

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF ST. MARTINVILLE, LOUISIANA
HELD ON THE 17th DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2018.

The Mayor and City Council of the City of St. Martinville, Louisiana met in Regular Session on the 17th day of September, 2018 at City Hall, their regular meeting place, pursuant to the call of the Mayor.

Mayor Melinda Mitchell presiding, called the meeting to order.

Upon motion of Dennis Williams duly seconded by Juma Johnson and unanimously carried that the minutes of the regular meeting held September 10, 2018 hereby be approved as written and prepared for publication in the Teche News, the Official Journal of the City of St. Martinville.

Upon motion of Dennis Williams duly seconded by Mike Fuselier and unanimously carried that the bills to be paid by the City Finance Committee hereby be approved for payment.

Upon motion of Mike Fuselier duly seconded by Dennis Williams and unanimously carried that Rusty Wilson with Appraiser Associates of Louisiana, Inc be hired to perform an appraisal at the cost of \$1,850.00 for the sale of approximately 0.630 acres, more or less, fronting on Main Street of the old Wal-Mart parking lot.

Upon request of April Viator with SMSH REACH Club, it was moved by Craig Prosper duly seconded by Dennis Williams and unanimously carried that permission be granted for the use of the Festival Grounds on Saturday, October 27th to hold a Haunted House. It was further discussed that the Old Pool Shed in Magnolia Park is also be available. Mayor Mitchell was given the authority to approve the location that best fits the organizations needs.

Upon request of April Viator with SMSH Reach Club, it was moved by Mike Fuselier duly seconded by Juma Johnson and unanimously carried that permission be granted to hold an Anti-Bully Walk on Saturday, November 3, 2018 from SMSH to Magnolia Park Pavilion from 9:30am until noon. A ceremony will be held at the Magnolia Park Pavilion following the walk.

Upon motion of Craig Prosper duly seconded by Mike Fuselier and unanimously carried that the following rates be adopted for personnel and equipment for Public Works Department to perform utility related work on private property.

The following is a list of costs for city employees and equipment that will be used to charge individuals responsible for repairs when city property is damaged or when the city is doing work that is the responsibility of the individual or business.

The employee regular time includes payroll taxes, retirement, worker's comp insurance, unemployment insurance and the city's portion of all health benefits that each employee has selected.

The employee overtime rate includes payroll taxes, , worker's comp insurance, unemployment insurance on the hourly rate at time and a half.
